Celebrating a year of academic excellence

Johnson & Wales is powered by a belief that every student deserves a high-quality education that can prepare them for success in a meaningful career. JWU takes intentional steps to embrace and champion a teacher-scholar model and we celebrate scholarship, research, and faculty excellence. Over the last year, JWU faculty have secured new grants to advance the body of knowledge in their fields, and the university has invested in student academic supports.

NATIONAL INSTITUTES OF HEALTH (NIH) RESEARCH GRANT AWARDED

Samantha Rosenthal, Ph.D. (College of Health & Wellness) is leading a team of JWU faculty that has received a three-year NIH grant that will explore the impacts mobile screen time has on college students' mental health. The grant will support the creation of a new undergraduate research center. This is the first NIH grant awarded to a JWU faculty member.

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

In late 2021, JWU and the University of Rhode Island were awarded a U.S. Department of Agriculture grant to develop new approaches to student learning through food systems. Jason Evans, Ph.D., dean of JWU's College of Food Innovation & Technology, is serving as the grant's lead investigator.

REIMAGINING THE FACULTY CENTER FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND INNOVATION

Through the **PURPOSE 2024** strategic plan, Johnson & Wales University has committed to providing faculty with ongoing support and resources in their pursuit of research, scholarship and innovation. To support this commitment, the university has launched an effort to establish a new faculty development program through the Faculty Center for Academic Excellence and Innovation. The center will help train faculty to educate and serve a more diverse student body. This work is supported in part by a Presidential Planning Grant from the Davis Educational Fund.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS CENTER

The Academic Success Center provides high-quality academic success services and programs that deepen students learning. The Academic Success Center is a welcoming and supportive environment for all students to connect with Johnson & Wales University staff, professional tutors, peer tutors and success coaches in an integrated and coordinated array of academic initiatives from subject tutoring to academic workshops to supplemental instruction to major and themed-based first-year learning communities.

The center moved into the first floor of The Yena Center this fall. This newly remodeled space was designed to enhance the educational experience for all students.

Founded in 1914, Johnson & Wales University is a private, nonprofit, accredited institution with more than 9,000 graduate, undergraduate and online students at its campuses in Providence, Rhode Island and Charlotte, North Carolina. An innovative educational leader, the university offers undergraduate and graduate degree programs in arts and sciences, business, engineering, food innovation, hospitality, nutrition, health and wellness. It also offers undergraduate programs in culinary arts, dietetics and design. JWU's unique model provides students with the personalized attention, academic expertise and industry connections that inspire professional success and personal growth. The time students spend at JWU is nothing short of transformative, as demonstrated by career outcomes, expected earnings and economic mobility rankings. The university's impact is global, with alumni in 125 countries pursuing careers worldwide.

RANKINGS

The *Wall Street Journal/Times Higher Education* has listed JWU on its 2021 College Rankings, which focuses on students' engagement with studies, interaction with teachers and satisfaction with educational experience.

U.S. News & World Report ranked JWU No. 16 for Best Undergraduate Teaching in the Regional North category. JWU also placed in the Regional North's Best Colleges Overall and Top Performers on Social Mobility. The latter measures how well schools graduated students who received Pell Grants, given to students from households with annual incomes of less than \$50,000.

Money Magazine also ranked JWU among its Best Colleges for 2020–21 by its value, quality of education, affordability and outcomes including graduates' earnings, employment status, career trajectory and socioeconomic mobility.

95% of On-Campus Students Receive Financial Aid

JWU is committed to making a quality education as accessible and affordable as possible. The university has taken proactive steps to manage student debt by increasing institutional aid over the past several years. Approximately 95% of all JWU on-campus students receive institutional scholarships and/or grants from the university, often making an education at JWU more affordable than other universities.

CAREER OUTCOMES RATE

Johnson & Wales University enjoys a 97.7% career outcomes rate for 2019 graduates who earned a bachelor's degree. This rate reflects the percentage of JWU graduates who secure full or part-time employment, are enrolled/accepted in a program of study to continue their education, are performing voluntary service, or enlist in military service within six months of graduation. The JWU rate is 11% higher than the national average.

Total of \$25,500 was awarded to nine students having difficulty affording their tuition and fees.

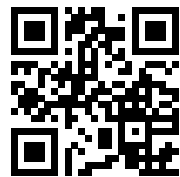
- Many of these students and their families had been directly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, which affected their resources for college related expenses
- Funds awarded to two freshmen, two sophomores, two juniors, and three seniors studying culinary arts, business, health science, criminal justice, and marketing; from Providence, Charlotte and North Miami campuses

Awards, based on need, ranged from \$1,000 to \$4,000. The total amount of funds that the university awarded in 2020-2021 reached just over \$160 million.

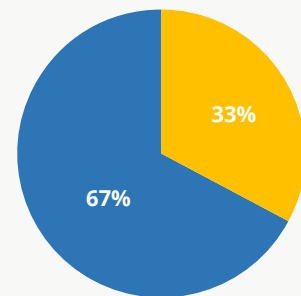
oneJWU

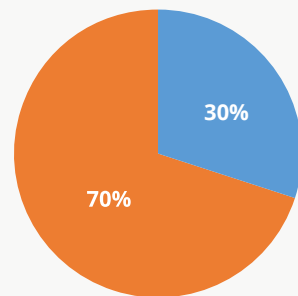

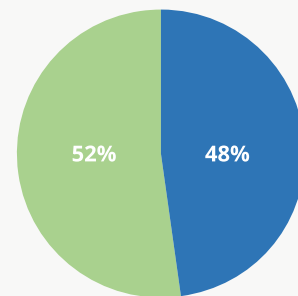

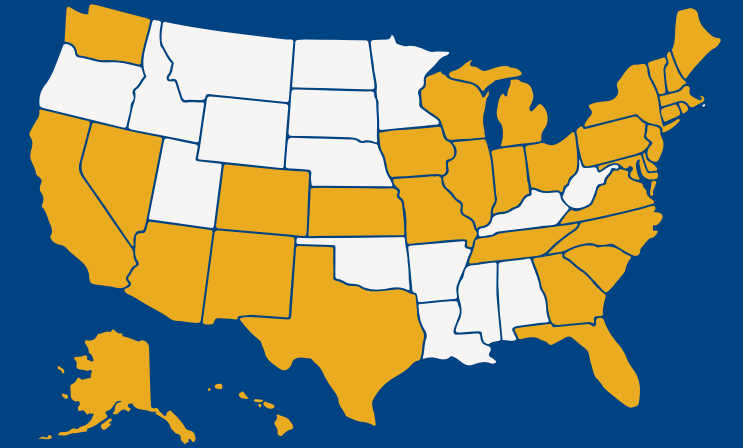

Financial Report

Despite a turbulent 2021, Johnson & Wales University ended the fiscal year with a record-breaking investment balance, and reduced debt by over \$75 million. By June 30, 2021, the entirety of the Denver Campus and a portion of the North Miami Campus had been sold. These sales provided for the defeasance of \$59 million in debt, with the remaining proceeds used to support operations. For the past few years, the Board of Trustees has appropriated additional funding to support operations. COVID-19 relief funding received through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund and the campus sales, eliminated the need for additional appropriations in FY2021. The increase in net assets of \$16 million is due to stellar investment returns, which are offset by losses from continuing and discounting operations. Discontinued operations reflect the operating results of the closed campuses and losses on sale of the properties.
